CATCHY COMMENTS

Top news for this month has to be the **Grand Slam** for the **Marlin Magic** crew! **Buddy, Danny and Ryan Noland** each contributed to the effort on August 3rd out past the "Cigar" along the 500-fathom line. Buddy got the white marlin on 30 general first. Ryan chipped in with a blue marlin on 80 general. And Danny completed the slam with a sailfish on 80 general! I wonder, is this a first for the club? Says Buddy, "it only took us 19 years to get a grand slam"! Way to go guys!! (Check out the story and pictures on the club website)

Wreck fishing, especially for cudas, has been red hot (kinda like the weather)! A few larger amberjack have been entered, led by **Elly Robinson's** 30-0 on 6 general. So far, there have been five cuda entries. **Mickey Kodroff** has the top cuda with his 33-0 on 8 spin. These fish have been extremely aggressive, attacking tubes ripped along the surface. The main problem is the ratio of mangled tubes to landed fish, which in my case was 12 to 0! Elly also entered a 7-14 red snapper, a 28-8 cobia and a 4-6 dolphin, while **Rob Robinson** added a 9-0 grouper and 2-14 black sea bass on their recent trip. **Scott Davis** came close to **Danny Noland's** new black sea bass record with a 4-4 on 4 plug. Away from the wrecks, Mickey

Kodroff also recorded a white marlin release and landed a nice 22-0 dolphin.

Inshore, I found some nice sized croakers, and wrestled several club records from **Scott Johnston**. I only managed to tie the 2 fly record, but set new ones for 4,6,8,12 and 16 fly as well as 8 spin. All the fish were 1-13 to 2-0. Red drum are on the feed in the Neuse River. Several club boats have fished the area, with entries from **Ronnie Sides, Quentin Corbett, Stamford Niou** and **Eddy Johnston** so far. Ronnie has the largest so far with a 36-0 on 20 general.

Away from home waters, **Quentin Corbett** enjoyed a day on the Bahamas bonefish flats, and landed a 6-0 on 8 general. **Bill Rewalt** registered a fantastic 25 pacific sailfish releases during a weeklong tournament at Pinas Bay, Panama! All but one were caught on 16 general. Bill also added a club record 12-4 rainbow runner on 16 general to his list of accomplishments.

We have also had some fantastic freshwater catches. Tops is **Mike Baucom's** 23-0 flathead on 2 general that scored a whopping 575 points! To hear **Fred Murray** tell it, this was quite a fight! Another big cat story is **Scott Davis's** 52-0 club record blue cat on 8 general! **Scott Johnston** improved his 8 fly record for gar to 6-8. **Fred Cousins** took the lead for the gar cup with a 12-8 on 2 spin, but it only lasted 12 days. **Rob Robinson's** 13-8 is the new leader. Scott also grabbed the 6 fly record for largemouth bass, with a 4-8. Numerous trips to Chickahominy Lake finally paid off for **Eddy Johnston**, with a 9-10 club record bowfin on 4 general.

July's angler of the month honors went to **Fred Cousins** for his 12-8 gar on 2 spin that scored 454 points. **Fred Murray** took second place with a 36-0 blue catfish on 4 general that scored 450 points. **Scott Davis's** 4-4 black sea bass on 4 plug was good for third place, scoring 283 points.


MICKEY KODROFF – ANGLER EXTRORDINAIRE!

In late June, Mickey traveled to Labrador with one goal in mind. That was to catch and release the last two fish he needed to earn his Freshwater Expert rating. He achieved that goal and then some! His five entries from that trip were all club records! The two that really mattered were a huge 7-8 brook trout on 8 fly that scored 545 points and a 6-4 northern pike on 8 fly that scored 156 points. These entries, along with several other notable catches, did indeed earn the FWE rating for Mickey.

Some of Mickey's other entries for FWE include his club record 10-12 largemouth bass on 12 general, a club record 3-4 hickory shad on 4 plug, a 4-0 rainbow trout on 4 fly, a 6-0 American shad on 4 general and a 7-0 landlocked striped bass on 4 plug. The big bass was caught on one of his trips to Mexico. The rainbow came from a Montana trip. Any way you look at it, Mickey has accomplished something extraordinary in earning the FWE award. **He is the only club member to earn all of our angler ratings!**

Mickey joined the club in 1975. In 1986, he earned Saltwater Expert. In 1992, Mickey earned the club's first Fly Expert award. In 1995, Mickey became our forth Master Angler. Then he went to work on the rest of the division expert ratings, earning Spin Expert and General Expert in 1998 and Plug Expert and Surf Expert in 2001. Now, in 2002, the quest is over! He has all of the ratings. He is our Angler Extraordinaire!!!


