# October Membership Meeting Speaker: Bob Pride Recreational Fishing Alliance in Virginia

Bob Pride, Acting Virginia State Chairman for the RFA, will be the speaker at the October meeting of the VAC. Bob will be giving a wide ranging presentation concerning establishment of a RFA presence in the Commonwealth of Virginia and what the RFA is doing on the national level. He will comment on current developments in the coastwise management of stripers and some interesting wrinkles associated with the drive to protect the Atlantic white marlin. He will also let us see some of the regulatory

activity coming up in the Year 2003 associated with weak fish, stripers and summer flounder.

Bob would like to get input from the membership on subjects and programs on which a Virginia RFA can be of assistance. Please be thinking up subjects and questions for Bob so we can have maximum benefit of his visit with us. This our chance to talk with "the man".

You may have heard that Bob was coming with Jimmy Donofrio, the

executive director of the RFA at the national level. Jimmy has a conflict with some lobbying work on Capital Hill and felt he needed to be present with those tasks that unfortunately came up on meeting night. Jimmy is assisted by Michael Doebley who is the RFA legislative director and works more in a behind-the-scenes role than does Jimmy.

Since 1990, Bob as been hard at work as a volunteer worker and a volunteer advisor working with such groups as the CCA, the National Marine Fisheries Service, the Mid-Atlantic Fisheries' Management Council, the VMRC and other national, regional and state groups concerned with management and preservation of the recreational angling environment. Bob recently obtained his six-pack charter license and is just getting his lines out as a charter captain.

Bob will be joining the Grub Gang which meets on membership meeting nights about 5:15 PM at Byrum's Restaurant in the shadow of the Channel 6 TV tower on West Broad Street. Come join the group if you get a chance.

Flatheads rule, again!! For the second straight month, angler of the month honors were captured by catching a monster flathead. Mike Baucom's 23-0 ruled last



Red drum have been hot and cold in the barrier island surf. We have had several very good days, with zips and single fish days mixed in. **Lynn Spurlin** had a three fish day (32, 36 and 37), **Glenn Carter** had a pair of 38's, **Bob Shepherd** landed a 34 and a 39 and his brother Bill scored with a 45 and 34. I've worked hard for my catches this fall, with 14 reds in the 30's and 4 in the 40's in 22 days of fishing. My top red this fall is a 47-0. One 44-0 has made my day twice! I tagged him on 9/17 and caught him again on 9/30! He was strong as a bull the second time around, and is back out there looking for somebody else to play with!



#### ANGLING RULES

The board of directors approved changes in basic weights for blue catfish to take effect December 1, 2002. The new weights will be published in the November newsletter.

During the past two monthly meetings, the board reviewed and discussed at length the lines approved for use for club activities. There was no action taken and no change made in the current rule. The most recent line test report indicates a vast majority of non-IGFA rated lines exceed the IGFA limit for wet breaking strength. Of 52 lines tested, 77% failed and many exceeded the limit by 50% or more. Eighty percent of the IGFA rated lines passed, as did Stren Original.

The Nominating committee members; Bruce Henderson, Scott Johnston and Mike Cline are looking for a few good men willing to step up and help with the club's business and activities. His list also includes a 44-0 blue catfish on 4 general, a 7-2 largemouth bass on 4 plug, a 11-4 musky on 6 general, a 11-4 landlocked striper on 4 general, a 23-0 Chinook salmon on 8 fly and a 3-0 smallmouth bass on 2 spin. 




