September Program - Fishing Casa Mar, Costa Rica

How many of you all remember the travel logs presented at the Mosque in years past? Robert Thomas of Fly Fish The World will keep the tradition alive by presenting an illustrated fishing log of an April trip Robert and 9 other area fly fishing enthusiasts took to Casa Mar, Costa Rica. VAC member Scott Johnston and his son were among the group. Angling was done with fly and spinning tackle. Casa Mar is on the east coast of Costa Rica and offers angling for tarpon, snook and other jungle species (jungle rules in effect??). Robert told me that bringing your own gear to Casa Mar is not necessary because this angling camp offers its own tackle that is high class gear that is equal to the task the targeted fish present. At the end of his presentation, Robert will take questions specific to the trip and also questions specific the fine art of flycasting.



August's Angler of the Month was **Elly Robinson**.
Elly released a 28-0 barracuda on 6-spin that scored 430 points. **Dennis Cline** claimed second and third place with a 19-4 African pompano on 6-plug worth 427 points and a 32-0 cuda on 8-spin that scored 400 points.



The wrecks off Ocracoke produced some nice catches for several other members. They included barracuda for **David English** (20-0), **Mike Cline** (25-0) and **Robbie Robinson** (30-0), who also landed a 2-4 black sea bass on 4-plug. **Elly Robinson** also chimed in with a 12-8 African on 6-plug. Closer to home, **Buddy Noland** caught a couple of nice black sea bass off the Triangle wrecks. One was a 4-0 on 6-plug and the other a 2-8 on 2-plug.

Dr. Jim Wright handed in a fistful of entries this month. While not all of them met club requirements, each was a potential citation fish in the VSFT. His catches included a 3-8 croaker, a 7-0 flounder, a white marlin release, a 75" shark release, a 9-8 sheepshead and a 49-0 wahoo. By my count, that brings him up to 15 species for citations this year.


Elsewhere in saltwater, **Tony Horsley** landed a pretty 6-4 flounder on 12 general off Cape Charles. **Scott Johnston** added another first for the club, a spot on 2 fly. His huge 0-4 spot is the smallest fish to ever qualify for a club record!! But never fear. I'm sure that Scott will improve on this record in the near future.


Success, finally!!! After a handful of members spent about 25 cumulative days battling sharks, rays and greenhead flies on the ES backcountry, several tarpon were finally caught and released. **Bob Shepherd** scored first with a 52-0 on 16 general. Of course, Bob had to do it on his first

try! It took me about ten days on the water to get lucky, but I was real lucky. My tarpon came back-to-back. The first was a 60-0 that made a couple of great jumps, but never ran. After a few very loud yahoos and a gulp of Gatorade, the same rod doubled up again. Thirty-six minutes after the first, the second was landed. It was a tough 81-0 that made three great jumps and scorched off 150 yards of line. 'Twas the stuff dreams are made of!!!

Switching to freshwater, **Scott Johnston** claimed the 12-fly record for smallmouth bass with a 3-0 from the New River in West Virginia. **Eddy Johnston** released a 4-4 bowfin and a 10-8 gar on 2-general on Chickahominy Lake. **Bill Gallasch** and Glenn Carter scored on James River flatheads. Bill's fish was a club record 25-0 on 8-general and Glenn's was a 20-0 on 4-general.

Finally, two members just returned from separate trips to Alaska. **Rich McDaniel** released a 10-12 Coho on 6-fly that scored 383 points somewhere in Alaska. Earlier that same week, **Bill Carter** and several friends enjoyed excellent fishing around Seward and on the Kenai River. Bill set club records for Coho salmon on 8-general and 12-plug with fish weighing 7-14 and 9-2 respectively. He also entered a club record 3-2 rainbow trout on 8-spin and a smaller rainbow on 6-fly. The party enjoyed lots of action with Dolly Varden, grayling and northern pike as well. For more details, check with Bill at the next club meeting.
