The Virginia Anglers Club Annual Meeting / Awards Banquet will be held at the Virginia Crossings Conference Center and Resort on January 27, 2007. The Resort is the former Figee's facility located just 1 mile east of US Route 1 on Virginia Center Boulevard. The VCB is 1.1 miles north on US Route 1 from Exit 43 on I-295. As in years past, the meal will be a buffet offering. A cash bar will be available. The Resort's signature clam chowder leads off a great meal. The meat choices on the buffet will be salmon, chicken breasts and Smithfield pork chops. Salads, vegetables, breads and desserts round out the meal. The \$12,500 budget was approved with one minor modification as submitted by Club Treasurer Fred Cousins. The two major adjustments to the budget over the 2006 budget were moving the anticipated banquet reservation expense to December from January and an addition of an income/expense wash of \$500 for the return of the "old style" Club "T" shirts with Bob Shepherd's artwork on the back.

From Washington, DC Take I-95 South. Exit 86B onto Route 656, Elmont West. At second light, turn left onto Route 1 South for one mile. Turn left onto Virginia Center Parkway. Follow Virginia Center Parkway for 9/10 of a mile and turn left into the Resort entrance.

From Charlottesville, Virginia

Take I-64 East to I-295 South. Follow I-295 for 8 miles. Stay in right lane and merge "To Exits 43 D-C-B-A, US 1". Take Exit 43C US 1 North to Ashland. Exit ramp will merge onto US 1 North (Brook Road). Follow US 1 for 3/10 of a mile to first stop light at Virginia Center Parkway, turn right. Follow Virginia Center Parkway for 9/10 of a mile and turn left into the Resort entrance.

From Virginia Beach / Norfolk, Virginia

Take I-64 West to I-295 North. Follow I-295 north for 15 miles. Stay in right lane and merge "To Exit 43 B-C-D toward Richmond/Ashland /US 1". Take Exit 43C to Ashland and US 1 North. Exit ramp will merge onto US 1 North (Brook Road). Follow US 1 to first stop light at Virginia Center Parkway, turn right. Follow Virginia Center Parkway for 9/10 of a mile and turn left into the Resort entrance.

From Richmond, Virginia & North Carolina

Take I-95 North to Exit 84 B. Exit ramp will merge on to I-295 North. Remain in right lane. Take Exit 43C to Ashland and US 1. Exit ramp will merge onto US 1 North (Brook Road). Follow US 1 to first stop light at Virginia Center Parkway, turn right. Follow Virginia Center Parkway for 9/10 of a mile and turn left into the Resort entrance.
