(Commentary from the Board of Directors)

By-Law Change Vote

Four (4) proposed amendments and/or additions to the By-Laws of the Virginia Anglers Club will be voted upon at the November Membership Meeting. The exact text of the proposed amendments and additions are printed on page 5 in the October issue of the Angler. The first amendment removes the word "male" from the requirements for membership in the VAC. The other three changes are for clarity and completeness of the By-Laws of the VAC and are "housekeeping" in nature. Come to the November Membership Meeting prepared to vote in favor of or against these by-law changes and additions. The vote will be by a show-of-hands vote of those members present who are eligible to vote and vote. Paid-up Resident and Non-resident Members and Life Members may vote. Honorary Members do not have voting privileges. The vote to approve for changes in or additions to the By-Laws requires a two-thirds (2/3rds) vote in favor of the changes or additions.

Board of Directors Reaches Closure on Recommended Changes



CATCHY COMMENTS

It appears that the drought has kept the fishermen in close over the past month with only one entry card turned in outside the state of Virginia. **Billy Corbitt** turned in a 2 lb. 8 oz. Spotted Seatrout caught from the surf at Buxton, N.C. for 125 points. Could have used those points in the Cape Hatteras Anglers Club Surf Tournament!

Victor Skakandy turned in several fish on 4# spin with a Spotted Seatrout weighing 3 lb. 12 oz. and a 6 lb. 8 oz. Red Drum worth 187 and 130 points. **Scott Johnson** was busy fly fishing on the York River for Stripers and landed numerous fish with the largest being 5 lb. 12 oz. on a half & half fly on 6 # tippet. **Scott** rarely lays down the fly rod, but also had a 3 lb. 1 oz. Flounder entry on 4# plug from Winter Harbor. Not to be outdone on the salty water, **Elly Robinson** and **Glen Carter** slipped down to Lynnhaven to beat **Scott** (the Elder), out of the lead for that stealthy specie, Spot. Mission accomplished with a 10 ounce Spot caught by **Elly** on 2# spin for 231 points on Fish Bites. The competition really heats up this time of the year!

Bruce Henderson wins the "Most Distance Traveled Award" this month. He followed Capt. Ken Neil's advice from the October membership meeting for catching Tilefish. Bruce and crew fished the Triangle Wrecks, Capt. Neil's "hot lump", and farther out to the walls of the Norfolk Canyon. No Tilefish were found but some nice Black Seabass were caught and future "hot spots" located. **Bruce** now leads the Black Seabass specie with a 3 lb. fish on 8# plug for 187 points.

On the freshwater scene, **Fred Cousins** takes another specie lead from **Scott Johnston** with a Chain Pickerel weighing 2 lb. 11 oz. worth 268 points. Scott is evidently carrying the "bull's-eye" on his back this month!

Five members and one guest fished the VAC Escatawba Farms Trout Tournament several weeks ago with each catching from 20-30 Rainbows. Brooks, and Brown Trout each. The weather was perfect and the lunch left from the VT/BC football game went down easier several days after the VT loss. Elly Robinson was reluctant to fish the tournament at first, then with his 5-gallon bucket in one hand and his cooling fan (remember Linus's blanket) in the other, was ready to compete! Elly's lucky charms paid off as he did manage to land the highest point Rainbow which was a 2 lb. 6 oz. on 2# fly for 185 points. Ricky Dale caught the heaviest Rainbow, a 3 lb. 2 oz. on 4# fly, and leads the Lunker category for this year. Removing John's Creek from the equation sure makes a difference from last year! Fred Cousin's entered a nice 1 lb. 8 oz. Brook Trout on 2# fly for 214 points but was beat by **Danny Noland's** 1 lb. 10 oz. Brook for 232 points. Even though the Brown's were on the small side, **Danny** also entered a 1 lb. 15 oz. fish on 2# tippet for 151 points. The "Overall Champion" of the tournament with the highest accumulation of points for the three species was Danny. Elly, though, was not discouraged and being the fierce competitor that he is, made a late furious charge with a Rainbow, a Brown, and a 6 inch long Brookie "release" for 50 points! You would have thought that fishing in the "handicapped pond" all day would have produced a larger Brookie.

By the way, I did receive confirmation from the IGFA that my 25 lb. 14 oz. Almaco Jack was certified as a World Record for the 8# class.

Angling Rule Changes for 2008

Tournaments

Before the angling year begins, the club will publish a list of scheduled tournaments. There may be changes to the tournament schedule that will be communicated to the members. Tournament winners will be awarded for the heaviest and the highest point fish of the target species caught in compliance with club rules. Tournament entries must be communicated to the tournament chairman within five days of the conclusion of the tournament and angler must specify if entry is for weight or points. The line size that is permissible for weight entry is only restricted by the maximum line size that has a basic weight for the targeted fish. (For example: The basic weight for the Hickory Shad stops at 12-lb. line, so tournament entries for Hickory Shad on 16lb. line would not be permitted.) There is no minimum weight restriction for winning weight fish. Entry cards are not required for tournament entries; however, points, angler ratings and club records are only possible with entries made on an entry card. In the event of a tie, the first entry reported to the tournament chairman will be declared the winner.

First place tournament winners for both weight and points will be awarded with their choice of one of the following:

- 1) \$40 gift card from Greentop Sporting Goods
- 2) Tournament trophy
- 3) Free ticket to annual Virginia Anglers Club banquet

Annual Tournament Champion Awards

Each of the top three finishers in each tournament for both points and weight will be awarded tournament points towards the annual saltwater and freshwater tournament champion awards as follows: First place—3 tournament points; second place—2 tournament points; third place—1 tournament point. At the end of the angling year, the angler with the most accumulated tournament points for both points and weight in each the freshwater and saltwater tournaments will be awarded the annual tournament champion award. In the event of a tie, both anglers will be awarded the annual tournament champion award. This award will be the angler's choice of one of the following:

- 1) \$40 gift card from Greentop Sporting Goods
- 2) Tournament Champion Trophy
- 3) Free ticket to annual Virginia Anglers Club banquet


