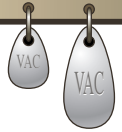
(Commentary from the Board of Directors)

CATCHY COMMENTS

Another year is behind us with *Brown Trout* catches by **Reggie White** from as far South as Argentina and huge *Halibut* landed in Alaska by **Bill Duval** to the North. The highest point saltwater entry by **Jim Sheffield**, a 50-9 *Striped Bass* on 2# for 1011 points, held on entire year. But this was no surprise since **Jim's Striper** is also the current 2# class IGFA World Record.

Fred Cousins caught the highest point freshwater fish last February that was a 22-2 pound *Carp* on 2# spin for 687 points which also held on to the lead the remainder of the year. There were 19 different species entered in freshwater and 17 species in saltwater this past season. "Local" species not entered this year were *Brook* and *Brown Trout* for freshwater and *Spadefish* on the saltwater side.

During the previous month, there were numerous entries but little movement in the species leads. **Mickey Kodroff** had the only surf entry with a 4-8 pound *Spotted Seatrout* on a Gulp bait for 225 points caught from the beach in Kitty Hawk, N.C...

Parks Rountrey and **Bob Brown** went to Oak Orchard, New York, November 13th for some cold weather fly fishing. Using an egg fly pattern, **Parks** landed an 18-8 pound *Chinook Salmon*. Later that day, **Parks** also caught a 4-0 pound *Brown Trout*. All on 6# fly. I guess *Flathead Catfish* is **Bob's** specialty since he had no entries from this trip.

Ryan Noland was fly fishing on the Little River and caught several nice *Rock Bass*. The first one was the largest, but didn't get weighed until he questioned whether there were any entries this year. The answer being no, **Ryan** put the second catch on the scale which was 0-8 ounces on a Halloween Woolly Bugger for 166 points. This fish now leads the specie. Only other *Rock Bass* entry was non-local by **Scott Johnston** from the Detroit River.

Glenn Carter and **Parks Rountrey** were *Crappie* fishing on the James River near the end of November. **Glenn** had the largest fish which was a 1-13 pound on 4# plug for 226 points and **Parks** turned in a 1-3 *Crappie* on 2# spin for 188 points. They must not have trusted each other to read the scale since, **Glenn** had his wife **Judy** witness the weight on his *Crappie* and **Parks** had **Karen** witness his fishes weight.

Fred Cousins fished Cripple Creek for *Rainbow Trout* to finish out his year. The best catch being a 4-7 pound *trout* on 2# spin for a total of 277 points. **Fred** said that the water was real "clear" and fish spooky and hard to catch, especially on fly. But, he did manage one good catch on fly, a 2-4 *Rainbow* on a wooly bugger.

Fishing for *Spotted Seatrout* on the Elizabeth River, **Danny Noland** and **Ryan Noland** had a good day as far as the quantity of *Trout*. The quality was a little lacking though. They had over 30 fish with only 6 keepers. The best was a 3-12 pound on 2# spin for **Danny** worth 250 points. **Dean Winstead** and **Jeff Doughty** have also been fishing the same area with some nice catches. I guess as soon as the freezer is full, they will start sport fishing!

Jim Sheffield ended the year just as dramatic as he started it. **Jim** was eel fishing for *Stripers* with **Bruce Henderson** around the Kiptopeke Beach area of the bay when he hooked and landed another potential IGFA world record. Using 4 pound Ande line, **Jim** landed a 44-2 pound *Striped Bass* worth 735 points. What a year!!!!

The New VAC Angling Year has started with several Striper entries this month. Good luck on a successful year.

Anglers take note of rule changes for 2009

- 1) Rule change: Time limit - 24 hours following event to turn in fish - to avoid unnecessary lag time in reporting tourney winner results. (5 day delay reduced excitement and often prohibited announcing results at Tuesday meetings).
- 2) Rule Change: Only 2 fish of a species may be entered per person (to avoid one person racking up too many points in a poorly attended tournament.) Fish can be entered in either weight or points category or one of each. This will foster more strategy and tighter competition for the year - weight vs points. (Note: in a multi-species tourney, 2 of each species can be entered)
- 3) Rule clarification: There is no minimum weight or minimum points required for a tournament entry.

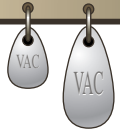

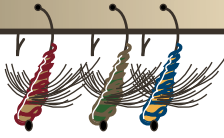
