CATCHY COMMENTS by Buddy Nolan

Evidently, not much has been happening in Saltwater since the last membership meeting because of the recent snow and high winds. Marlin Mania, out of Hatteras, continues to catch *Blackfin Tuna*, *Amberjack*, and *Little Tuny* jigging with metal and 80# braid outfits. **Ricky Dale** recently went with him and caught a limit of the *Blackfin* with the *Amberjack* and *Little Tuny* mix over the Southeast Rocks about 30 miles out.

In Freshwater, the *Yellow Perch* were slow starting this year with just a few entries. **Ryan Noland** had several good days on the Northwest River with a variety of species. He leads the *Yellow Perch* with a 0-15 perch on 2# spin for 246 points. **Ryan** also landed a 3-5 *Largemouth Bass*, a 2-11 pound *Chain Pickerel*, and a 4-3 *Bowfin* all on jigs and 2# line. The *Pickerel* leads the Freshwater Spin Division with 268 points. **Danny Noland** also fished the Northwest River and entered a 0-7 *Rock Bass* for 115 points which is now the current 2# plug Club Record.

Will Mosley has several nice entries from the Dragon Run part of the Piankatank River recently. His best catch being a 22-0 *Carp* on 2# plug worth 687 points for a new Club record and Plug Division lead. Great catch! **Will's** other entry was a 4-0 *Gar* on 2# plug for 145 points. Several days later, **Will** fished the James River and caught the first *Flathead Catfish* entry for this year. The fish weighted 36-0 pounds and on 6# plug is worth 525 points.

Parks Rountrey and **Mike Ostrander** were *Crappie* fishing on the James River recently. The largest entry was a 1-11 on 2# spin worth 267 points on a plastic grub. **Mike** entered a 1-8 *Crappie* on 2# spin for 238 points.

From the Chickahominy River, **Mike Cline** entered a 0-15 *Yellow Perch* on 2# plug worth 246 points caught on a Silver Buddy. Since **Ryan** had the earliest entry for *Yellow Perch*, he will still maintain the Specie lead.

Will Mosley and **Danny Noland** have been each fishing the Nottoway River for the early *Shad*, but no luck to date with the high water from the snow runoff. The Nottoway should be good by the weekend!

By the way, if anyone is interested in gathering "scallops" from Pamlico Sound off Hatteras, check with **Jeff Doughty**. He has become quite the expert lately. The *Puppy Drum* like them also.

PAY DUES OR MAKE A DONATION ON LINE

BEHIND IN DUES??? NO CREDIT FOR CATCH SUBMISSIONS

Any Entry Cards submitted for personal, club record or tournament credit **on or after March**, **1**, **2009** will be **disqualified** for credit if the Member submitting the card is not current with his/her dues. When the dues are paid after March 1, 2009, then credit will be given for catches made on or after the date the delinquent dues are received by the VAC Treasurer, as long as these catches are properly submitted on entry cards.

FRESHWATER FISHING VIRGINIA A GREAT SUCCESS

Saturday, March 7, 2009 was the date of the special Freshwater Fishing Virginia program sponsored by Green Top Sporting Goods, Fly Fishers of Virginia and our own Virginia Anglers Club. Speaking were **Bill Pearsall (FFV) and VAC members Robert** Thomas, Gary Martell, Capt. Mike Ostrander, Bob Shepherd and Eddy Johnston. A Bass Fishing for Kids program rounded out the series of seven subjects and was put on by three youth graduates of VCU's "Go Fish" Summer Program taught each summer by VAC's Capt. Mike Ostrander. Class attendance ranged upwards of 25 students for each class. Rob Choi and Bob Shepherd produced an informative and attractive full color handout about the club as well as a very large display scroll featuring images of many members and their notable catches. These latter two items will be available for use anytime the Club wants to set up an information center about the VAC. A good showing of prospective members is expected as a result of this effort. Special thanks to all of the above and other members who manned the booth and otherwise contributed to a very successful day.

Upcoming Tour nament

JAMES RIVER HICKORY SHAD & WHITE PERCH APRIL 4-5 (blow date APRIL 18 - 19)

The shad run usually extends from mid-March to the beginning of May. The tourney date is near peak shad time and just slightly before traditional peak perch time. If we are early in the runs fishing may be better down river as opposed to the I-95 area. The only potential problem is potential high muddy floodwaters that can sometimes make the James un-fishable for a few days in the spring. Small spoons, shad darts and very small plastic grubs can be effective on ultralight spinning and plug gear. Fly fishing is sometimes more productive than the spinning outfits. Various flies work well, mostly with sinking lines, and just enough rod to throw the sinking line. Perch are often caught while targeting shad with the same lures. In deeper water silver buddies are very effective on white perch. Contact Chairman to confirm event dates if weather or River conditions are questionable.

This is essentially 2 tournaments on the same weekend. A fish can be entered by weight or points (angler must declare which category) but not both ways for 1 fish.

One angler can win both weight and points divisions by entering 2 different fish.

One angler can only turn in two fish of each species (4 total).

Call in entries within 24 hours from the end of tournament to Angling Activities Chairman Parks Rountrey 804-349-6001. You can not change the entry category once you have registered it with the Chairman.

You do not need to fill out cards.
