

SEPTEMBER 30th EXPEDITION TROUT FISHING THE SOUTH RIVER IN WAYNESBORO, VA

Eric Webster will lead the final fishing expedition of 2017. He'll be taking the group to the Catch & Release section of the South River in Waynesboro, VA for a day of trout fishing on Saturday, September 30. The expedition will leave from the Parham Road Park & Ride lot at 8:00 AM SHARP. The lot is at the intersection of N. Parham Road and Fordson Road, just south of I-64. The trip to Waynesboro takes ~ 90 minutes. The group will park in the temporary lot just south of Constitution Park (the park is closed while the Main St bridge is being replaced), gear up and fish from 9:30 AM to 3:00 PM. After fishing, the group will head two blocks up W. Main Street to the Heritage on Main Street restaurant for a bite to eat.

Prices of the Calendars on "the open market" are noted to be from \$10.00 to \$13.00, a good point to make when selling Calendars at our price of \$8.00.



Participation in tournaments, as indicated by tournament card submission, has not met expectations. No tournaments will be scheduled during the 2018 Angling Year.










"Catchy Comments"







It is exciting to me to learn of a new fishery that is being developed and explored. In a world where all fish stocks seem to be exploited, it is nice to hear about a place and a fish, whose reported numbers seem to be almost too good to be true. The fishery that I refer to is for Blue Marlin far off the coast of Costa Rica. Many years ago, St. Thomas, Virgin Islands, became the mecca for Atlantic Blue Marlin around the full moon in August of every year. I fished

there, and the fishing was very good, but nothing like what is now being experienced offshore of Costa Rica.

The reports that I have gotten are all from fly fishermen that have fished this area. For the last few years, Jake Jordan of Havelock, North Carolina, has been conducting what he calls his Blue Marlin Fly Fishing School with great success. He takes his clients on George Beckwith's boat Dragin Fly out of Los Suenos, Costa Rica. As I understand, they are fishing some high peaks and anchored FADS (fish aggregating devices) 100 or more miles offshore, which require multiple day trips and favorable weather.

This brings me to the story that I find so exciting. Two friends of mine have returned from two days fishing in early September; their report was nothing short of amazing. This pair host trips each year to Casa Vieja Lodge in Guatemala to fish for sailfish on fly, and I have been on this trip a few times. The Guatemala sail fishing is very good, and these crews have honed their tackle set-up and technique to almost perfection. They troll hookless baits and tease the fish to within 30 feet from the stern where a switch to a cast popper fly is made. They do catch some marlin in Guatemala, but they are largely incidental catches while targeting sailfish.

My friends were able to convince one of the captains from Guatemala, Chris Sheeder, to bring a boat south to Costa Rica to try this Blue Marlin fishery. In two days fishing, 100-140 miles offshore of Quepos, they released 10 Blue Marlin, 1 Striped Marlin and 1 Sailfish all caught on fly on 20 lb. tippet. While this is amazing, even more amazing is that one day they raised or saw, 36 Blue Marlin, which is an extraordinary number.

I sometimes wonder what the fishing would be like if we could go back in time, with our current gear and boats, and fish about the time Captain John Smith was arriving in Jamestown. In my imagination I always see fishing that is similar to this current Blue Marlin fishing in Costa Rica.




MEET GUIDE COLBY TROW

Colby and his brother Brian opened up the shop together in 2003. He started guiding and instructing in Virginia in 1999 and has fished almost every day since 2003. When he isn't fishing he's at the vise tying flies. He started tying flies for local Virginia fly shops at age 13 and was featured at many fly fishing trade shows through his teen years. Although based in the Shenandoah Valley, Colby always has 'salt' on his mind. When he isn't hosting a trip in the Bahamas or Belize chasing bones, permit, tarpon, and cudas, he is out with his buddies chasing stripers, big drum, cobia, or billfish off the Virginia coast!


