Virginia Anglers Club JUNE PROGRAM REPORT



Snakehead Fishing Rich McDaniel

The invasive Snakehead appeared about 10 years ago in the shallow creeks and marshes around the pickerel grass on the Potomac river. They are a very visible target in the shallow water. Although the thicker grasses that grow in July make fishing rather difficult, Rich prefers fishing the outgoing tide as it brings the snakeheads out of the thicker grass. Even though Snakehead fishing has not been as good this year as in past years, Rich thinks the pressure from the bow fisherman is the reason.

Rich's Snakehead Secrets:

- Favorite Lure Black & Blue chatter bait with a trailer.
- Cast deep into the grass.
- Sight fish for them in the shallows.
- Look for the mud trails moving out of the shallows.
- He doesn't find the frog lure as effective.
- He prefers 16lb test mono, no leader.

<u>Alabama Bass</u> Mike Benadski

The invasive Alabama Spotted Bass are showing up in Virginia waters. They are an aggressive species and a threat to Large Mouth Bass. They will hybridize with Smallmouth Bass and could eliminate the species. They are nearly identical in appearance to the Spotted Bass. Alabama Bass are confirmed to be present in Lake Gaston, Claytor Lake, Philpott Lake, and Martinsville Reservoir. They will grow up to 5.8 to 6lbs.

In North Carolina, Lake Norman has seen the Largemouth Bass population decrease to less than 8% of their former abundance following the introduction of Alabama Bass. Anglers are reminded that it is illegal to transfer fish from lake to lake.

There is an Alabama Bass test, first take a picture of the fish and clip off a thumbnail sized portion of one of the pelvic fins and lastly contact DGIF.

June Small River Wade Expedition Report Mike Ostrander

On Saturday, June 27, nine members of the VAC met for the Small River Wade Fishing Expedition on a local small river. The shaded banks and cool river water provided comfortable relief from the heating day, making for a perfect early summer, fishing destination. This tributary of the York River can produce a day

where one can catch ten species of fish, or more. Generally, the bass fishing is pretty good, but on this day, the river was a bit stained and panfish, carp and catfish played the bigger role.

If I am correct, between the anglers, the following species were caught: largemouth bass, smallmouth bass, spotted bass, channel catfish, blue catfish, flathead catfish, common carp, grass carp, bluegill, green sunfish, redbreast sunfish, crappie, white perch, striped bass, for a total of fourteen species ... and if I'm not forgetting anything, I'm sure a long-eared sunfish and pumpkinseed sunfish were also caught raising the species count a couple more.

Five to thirteen pound common carp offered the greatest challenge and fun, in my opinion, especially on six pound line. The larger carp would take great runs up and down river, sometimes 30 yards or more, it seemed, in the river small enough to be a creek. Luckily, as the larger carp moved close to the downed trees, they would back off and move to open water. The highlight of the day had to be Jacob Nixon's 34 pound grass carp. As soon as the fish was hooked, it breached the river's surface and those who saw it knew immediately it was a giant grass carp! This river being little more than a big, deep creek and Jacob landed this massive grass carp without breaking off in the structure along both sides of the river the fish could have easily muscled into.

While we had private access to a spot on this river, it does have at least one public access point, upriver. We fished near Kings Dominion a handful of miles before it joins with the South Anna River to form the Pamunkey River. Can you guess the name of the river? I am not allowed to post the name of this river publicly, as there are passionate ghosts who fish this river and if it were to be written here, they would come out late one night and break the fishing pole I used in half. It's a gem ... give it a shot sometime and if you fish it, don't write or share it by name!

The expedition will take place in Hampton Va. with target species being Speckled Trout. More details will be coming soon.






Virginia Anglers Club VAC NEW MEMBER



I have a 10wt sage fly rod with reel and line that I bought new in 2009, and I will never use them. I test/practiced casted with them on the lawn a few times when new, but I never used them. They have never been on/in water. This, they are in absolutely new condition. They have been stored in a closet this entire time, and have no mold, dirt, or any such. In the following paragraphs I will describe the individual items.

The rod is a Sage Xí 2, 1090-4, #10 line, 9'0", 4 1/2 oz. I bought it from Cabela's for \$532.50.

The reel is a Ross Momentum GLD 6. I bought it from Cabela's for \$275. I have the original brand-new condition box with warranty card, etc.

The line is Scientific Anglers Mastery Series Quad Tip Saltwater, WF-10-F/S Green. The tips are as follows. 15' AST Floating. 15' Type I clear tip (1.5 - 2 ips). 15' Type III Wet Tip (3-5 ips). 15' Type V Wet Tip (6-8 ips). The line to tip connections are built in loop to loop. It has a "breathable mesh quad compartment wallet." I have the original box with spool in it. I bought the line, tips, and wallet as a one item set, from Cabela's for \$139.95.


