

President's Message

October 2020

I hope everyone is doing well, remaining safe and healthy ... and getting some fishing time in. I for one have been busy on the water both professionally, and for personal fun. I recently had the opportunity to fish with the new state record holder for fallfish. David Legg is a 71-year-old policeman who has fished the Jackson River for nearly all of those 71 years. Since DWR added fallfish to the list of game-fish available for citations and state records, David has caught over 30 citations and is the first Fallfish "Expert" in Virginia, as well as the state record holder with a 2-8 Fallfish.

The Gathright Dam was pulsing a major release of water the day we were to fish, and the flooded Jackson was out of the question. We decided to fish the Cowpasture River and it was our job (Lynda and I) to find a location that held nice sized fallfish. Tough job, but someone had to do it. Long story short, we finally found an area that looked good (and had camping close by). The sun was setting and had about 20 to 30 minutes to fish. About a quarter mile down a path was a beautiful long slow pool with about 50 yards of riffles at the base and another long deep pool followed by another round of deep-water holes. The fading sunlight and the peak colors of the fall foliage around us, combined with the beautiful Cowpasture River was worth everything it took to get there, and time allowed for enough casts with a Joe's Fly on four-pound line to score two huge fallfish. Naturally, I left my scale in the truck and can only guess at their weights. Another lesson learned, and hopefully not forgotten ... ever again!

We met David the next morning and fished hard for about five hours and didn't score a single fallfish over a pound. Fishing was tough with a few fallfish, sunfish and smallmouth bass. Perhaps it was the 40-degree morning and the cooler water temps, or the fish were busy enjoying the beautiful weather and not feeding. David says best fishing for fallfish is between 10am and 2pm, from March through August, but he catches them right through October. We camped and fished in the Walton Tract of the Cowpasture River and is a fine place for camping and fishing. If you are interested in catching a state record fish, I'd suggest chasing those Bath County Bonefish in a favorite hole you have or give the Cowpasture or Jackson a try.

I've been a member of the Virginia Anglers Club for about 20 years now and am so grateful to remain a part of this growing club. With all of the crazy things going on in the world today, the Virginia Anglers Club has an opportunity for a heck of year coming up. The excitement level from the new Expedition group that recently formed under the guidance of Frank Hart is leading the way for upcoming outings for all members. These Expeditions, or fishing trips, offer the opportunity to join in and fish either alone, or with a trusted fishing partner. Most trips are either wade fishing trips or boat trips that can be a kayak (single angler) or jon boat (one or two anglers). There are also a couple of Expeditions being planned for overnight fishing trips, and the group is hoping that we'll be able to actually do these trips in 2021.

Lastly, if you are interested in working within the leadership team in 2021, and no one has asked you directly, please reach out and let me know. Always looking for good help and we are currently in need of a few positions. Thanks, and I hope the rest of October and November offers you plenty of family time and fishing opportunities.

OCTOBER EXPEDITION REPORT

Our crew consisted of Mike Ostrander and wife Lynda in a jon boat, Steve Knox, Terry Midkiff, and myself in kayaks. The Speckled trout bite was hot with all anglers hooking up, it did not take long for our group to obtain their five fish limits. There was also a couple of flounder caught by Mike before the rain started moving in on us.

The Delta rains pushed us off the water by noon, when we arrived back at the ramp everyone had a great day with fish to take home for dinner. Thanks to everyone that made the trip, we will make this a VAC annual event.





PROGRAMS

October 27th - Capt. Chris Moore, Senior Ecosystem Scientist in the Chesapeake Bay Foundation's Hampton Roads Office (copied here), has agreed to be our speaker for our October 27 membership meeting. Chris is an avid angler, a VA Beach native, a graduate of Randolph-Macon (where he studied Environmental Science and played football), a founding member of the Northern Virginia Chapter of the Coastal Conservation Association (the only CCA chapter still active in VA), and an experienced speaker for angling clubs. Chris will give us his take on this week's annual meeting of the Atlantic States Marine Fisheries Commission (ASMFC), which will have important ramifications for the next several years in management of menhaden, rockfish, cobia, spot, and croakers. If any VAC member is interested in seeing the agenda for the ASMFC meeting, the agenda is at https://www.asmfc.org/home/2020-annual-meeting-webinar, along with instructions for attending specific sessions virtually.

Chris takes the lead on VA fisheries issues for CBF, in close cooperation with the Foundation's MD Fisheries Scientist, Dr. Allison Colden (another VA Beach native), who has a seat on ASMFC's Menhaden Board, and numerous other partners, including the VA Saltwater Sportsmen's Association (VSSA), of which VAC is a member. This ASMFC meeting and the winter one will determine the ecologically derived coastal and state-by-state Total Allowable Catch (TAC) for menhaden. And although word on the street is that VA's rockfish young-of-the-year survey is closer to average than MD's recently-released poor showing, it's clear that tighter coastwide restrictions are coming for our iconic stripers through ASMFC's proposed Amendment 7 to their management plan, which the commissioners will begin working on at this meeting. There will also be discussion of management

2021 VAC ANGLING RULE CHANGES

The Angling Rules Committee presented the new rule changes to the Board of Directors on 10/13/2020. The rule changes are based on input from VAC club members. The BOD has approved the rule changes and they will go into effect beginning with the 2021 angling year.

- Add kingfish (sea mullet, roundheads) to the list of saltwater species.

- Modify the length for shark release from 6' to 5' (fork length) to receive a release basic weight of 60 lbs.

- Reduce the basic weights for snakeheads.

- Reduce the basic weights for spotted seatrout.

- Modify the wording for the Youth Award to include the restriction that it applies to only non-club youth. See the following:

"Trophies will be awarded at the end of each angling year to any youth (non-club members), under age 18, fishing with a club member . . . "

2020–2021 Wildlife Regulation Review & Amendment Process

The Department of Wildlife Resources (DWR) is beginning its biennial process for changing the regulations guiding hunting, trapping, wildlife, and public lands recreational opportunities. DWR takes public opinion into account when developing regulations, and is looking for input on the hunting, trapping, general wildlife, and public lands regulations. This process offers the opportunity for citizens to suggest potential regulatory changes directly to DWR during the public scoping period, which will run from October 12, 2020 through December 11, 2020.

All items submitted will be reviewed by DWR staff. A summary of the comments received during the public scoping period will be presented to DWR's Wildlife and Boat Committee and the full Board in January 2021. At its March 2021 meeting, the Board will be receiving and considering regulation amendments recommended by DWR staffs and the public. For those regulation amendment recommendations proposed by the Board, a formal public comment period will be conducted from late March through early May 2021. The Board will take final action on its regulation amendment proposals at its May 2021 meeting. The public is welcome to participate in all phases of the regulation amendment process.

I have a 10wt Sage fly rod with reel and line that I bought new in 2009, and I will never use them. I test/ practiced casted with them on the lawn a few times when new, but I never used them. They have never been on/in water. This, they are in absolutely new condition. They have been stored in a closet this entire time, and have no mold, dirt, or any such. In the following paragraphs I will describe the individual items.

The rod is a Sage Xi 2, 1090-4, #10 line, 9'0", 4 1/2 oz. I bought it from Cabela's for \$532.50.

The reel is a Ross Momentum GLD 6. I bought it from Cabela's for \$275. I have the original brand-new condition box with warranty card, etc.

The line is Scientific Anglers Mastery Series Quad Tip Saltwater, WF-10-F/S Green. The tips are as follows. 15' AST Floating. 15' Type I clear tip (1.5 - 2 ips). 15' Type III Wet Tip (3-5 ips). 15' Type V wet Tip (6-8 ips). The line to tip connections are built in loop to loop. It has a "breathable mesh quad compartment wallet." I have the original box with spool in it. I bought the line, tips, and wallet as a one item set, from Cabela's for \$139.95.
